

**City of Red Bud  
Planning Commission Meeting  
February 20, 2018  
Meeting Minutes**

The February 20, 2018 meeting of the Red Bud Planning Commission was called to order by Chairman Andrea Letcher-Martin at 7:00 p.m.

Chairperson Letcher-Martin opened discussions on land use updated recommendations Jeff M. is developing additional use types and provided a copy to members for the existing use Schedule 40-3-7 (B) Use table. Mr. Mueller asked for additional input at the next meeting.

Chairman Letcher-Martin presented from Mayor Tim Lowry the City of Red Bud's Policy against Discrimination, Harassment and Sexual Misconduct Policy memo for all commission members to review and sign.
