Tim Fahey, chairman of the parks & recreation committee addressed the council in support of the splash pad and questioned the need to attach tax revenue to support a splash pad because of the low maintenance cost involved. The Mayor responded that he is not in favor of this resolution, but feels it needs more study in relationship to the total city budget. Council Member Reed explained his support of the resolution.

The vote was as follows: Esker, nay; Guebert, nay; Reed, aye; Hanebutt, nay; Linnertz, nay; Friess, nay; Donjon, aye. Motion failed by 2 aye - 5 nay votes.
