The meeting was called to order by Tim Fahey at 6:30 PM at Red Bud City Hall.

Minutes from the November 2023 meeting were approved as read.

OSLAD GRANT

- Bid advertisement for City Park Renovation and Splash Pad has been published. Bid opening will be on Friday, January 26, 2024 at 11:00 a.m.

POOL

- The YMCA bill was received and paid: Total of \$26,739.05, deficit loss \$20,741, management fee \$5,998.05.
- Tim will get bids for a new door and will decide how to replace window

LINCOLN PARK

- New tie downs were ordered and received for wind screens.
- Screens at Pickleball were removed on November 2, at 1:30.
- Spring work day we will paint parking blocks
- Trees have been planted at Lincoln Park and all have water bladders and mulch.
- ***Deb Opel made a motion to allow Pickleball teams to reserve pickleball courts for open play on Tuesdays and Thursdays from 6:30-8:30 p.m. Seconded by Wil Krick. Motion carried unanimously.***

RATZ PARK

- Dedication of Holitzer on November 11th went well.
- New Trees have been planted and have water bladders and mulch. Red Bud trees were planted near Howitzer.
- Tim will try and repaint the floors in the main men's restroom when weather permits. Doors were not kept locked long enough.

SPORTS COMPLEX

- Need to put security cameras in budget for 2024
- Kyle reported:
 - that to repair the batting cage the temperature needs to be above 70 degrees for the glue to work properly.
 - toilets in the woman's bathroom need to be replaced. He will get estimates.
 - would like WiFi in the complex. He will check with Pam, Susan, and HTC

COMMUNITY GARDEN

OTHER BUSINESS
