BUDGET

- Will also try to hire high school students to help
- Dead trees need to be removed
- Creek beds need to be cleaned out again. Starting to become overgrown.
- Tim and Jim will compile a list of jobs that could be completed by The Way Church from Columbia. They volunteered to help with projects in Ratz Park in May. They may include a few from Lincoln Park if there is time.
- Two new volleyball nets need to be ordered.

COMMUNITY GARDEN

- All boxes are spoken for
- Will add more next year
- Cameras approved and paid for.

LINCOLN PARK

- Muskets are not interested in the shed. City will take action to remove it.
- Soccer nets are up on goals
- Two Volleyball nets need to be replaced as well as court weeded and more sand added.
- Baseball field has been plowed and sand will be added and replowed
- Holes are cut for new pickleball courts and will be striped by the end of May.
- Basketball courts will also be striped.
- Committee would like to replace the Bar-b-que pits at The Fred Miller Pavilion this summer.
- New mulch is needed around the playground equipment.
- Committee discussed replacing the playground equipment. It has reached the end of its lifespan.
- Girls on the Run want to plant a couple trees in Lincoln Park. Committee agreed to the idea.
Ryan made a motion to allow Girls on the Run to plant two trees in Lincoln Park. Jim seconded the motion. Motion carried unanimously.
