- Cost approximately \$16,000 to replace pump and pipes. Under budget.
- Swim team has not received a response for using the pool for team practices.

RATZ PARK

- Recent storm damaged several trees, especially in Bums Jungle
- Fort in Bums Jungle was vandalized. Six Culprits were caught. One is incarcerated. Damage still needs to be painted over.
- The Way Church helped clean up after the storm but would like to return to finish work scheduled.
- Trees blown down by strom are partially removed, large pieces still there.
- Creek beds need to be cleaned out again. Becoming overgrown.

COMMUNITY GARDEN

- Cameras are installed and working

LINCOLN PARK

- Pickleball courts are still waiting to be completed. Weather has been a problem.
- Girls on the Run have planted three trees in Lincoln Park
- Chamber Fest will be held at Lincoln Park, October 21st and 22nd.
