**I. East Industrial Park Property Barrier**

Code Administrator Mueller reported that he had talked to two nurseries and they both said it would take about \$10,000 to purchase trees, plant them and guarantee them for 1 year for the barrier required on the east industrial park property. Their recommendations were to plant either river birch or maple trees and they should be planted in October/November. Fencing would cost around \$50,000. Mueller suggested holding off on this until September.
