### **ANNUAL APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE NO. 1520**

An ordinance making appropriation for the corporate purposes of the City of Red Bud, Illinois, for the fiscal year commencing on the 1st day of May A.D. 2023 and ending on the 30th day of April, A.D. 2024.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RED BUD, ILLINOIS:

SECTION 1: That the following sums or so much thereof as may authorized by law, be, and the same are hereby appropriated for the corporate purposes of the City of Red Bud, Illinois, to defray all necessary expenses and liabilities of said City of Red Bud, as hereinafter specified, and for the fiscal year commencing on the 1st day of May, A.D. 2023 and ending on the 30th day of April, A.D. 2024 to-wit:
