ORDINANCE NO. 1499

**AN ORDINANCE APPROVING INSURANCE TERM WITH
ILLINOIS MUNICIPAL LEAGUE RISK MANAGEMENT ASSOCIATION**

WHEREAS, pursuant to Article VII, Section 10 of the Illinois Constitution, the Intergovernmental Cooperation Act, 5 ILCS 220/1 et. seq., the City of Red Bud (hereinafter "City") has the authority to enter into Intergovernmental Agreements and Contracts with other governmental bodies for the joint exercise of powers, privileges, and authorities; and

WHEREAS, the City has entered into an Intergovernmental Agreement to obtain insurance on a yearly basis with the Illinois Municipal League Risk Management Association (IMLRMA) under an Ordinance approved on December 6, 2021; and

WHEREAS, the City has been presented with an offer of insurance with no rate increases under a two year commitment; and

WHEREAS, the City finds it to be in the public interest of the City to participate in the insurance offer for two years.

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RED BUD, ILLINOIS, as follows:

SECTION 1: That the above recitals are hereby made a part of this Ordinance as though written herein verbatim.

SECTION 2: The City Council does hereby authorize, adopt, and approve acceptance of the IMLRMA insurance offer of no rate increases for the next two years starting at the expiration of the current insurance term.

SECTION 3: The Acting Mayor and City Clerk shall execute and deliver any required documents to obtain the two year insurance offer to the IMLRMA. After that time, the Mayor and City Clerk shall execute and deliver any documents to obtain insurance coverage and maintain membership in IMLRMA on an annual basis and each year thereafter unless this Ordinance is repealed.

SECTION 4: This Ordinance supersedes all Ordinances or parts of Ordinances adopted prior hereto that are in conflict herewith, to the extent of such conflict only.

SECTION 5: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval, and signature by the Acting Mayor.


