- IV. Authorization to Hire Part-Time Officer**

Chief Brittingham handed out a proposal from Roy Walker Communications, Inc. for a SLR 5000 Series Repeater for the police department, in the amount of \$10,468. No action taken (*No quorum, will be on non-consent council agenda*)
- VI. Narcan Policy and Supply**
Chief Brittingham reported that it is state mandated that all officers carry Narcan and they be trained to use it in the case of heroin overdoses. Each dose cost is about \$5 and Brittingham prefers the nasal application, rather than injections. The city is required to have a policy and Chief Brittingham is acquiring a copy of Columbia's policy and will submit it to Attorney Ray. Chief Brittingham reported that eight groundhogs have been disposed of and he hopes he has gotten them all.
