Old Business

**I. Swimming Pool**

**A. Post Season Repairs Update**

Superintendent Eckart said he was working on getting a formalized price from the bricklayer and the concrete costs and hopes to have it for the April meeting. For the sand issue repairs, Eckart is planning on turning it on and hopefully isolating the problem, rather than put a bunch of holes all over the deck.

**B. YMCA Contract – Draft for Review**

Chairman Donjon asked that Poetker convey to the YMCA that Item 2, Page 1 of the agreement “April 30, 2021” be replaced with “with 45 days’ notice.” Poetker will have a clean copy for approval at the April council meeting.

**II. Security Camera(s) – Athletic Association/Concession Stand**

Chief Brittingham reviewed the security camera plan/cost estimate prepared by Greg Blake of the Muskets. The estimate for the costs to the city is \$5,306.60. There is no requirement for retaining the video tapes. Scott Voss, representing the Muskets, is requesting approval for the Muskets to go ahead with their portion of the proposal. The city’s portion could be added on at any time. The Muskets will take care of the internet costs. The police will have access to the Muskets’ cameras.
