Old Business

I. Splash Pad Project – Authorization to Apply for Grant

Recommendation made by Committee Chairman Donjon, seconded by Committee Member Harbaugh to approve applying for a 50/50 OSLAD Grant, NTE \$400,000, when it becomes available, for a splash pad. Carried, with Hanebutt voting nay.

III. Community Garden

Poetker applied for the Loews grant and they no longer offer it. Home Depot says the city is not eligible for their grant. Walmart will still be contacted by Poetker or Hanebutt.

Recommendation made by Committee Chairman Donjon, seconded by Committee Member Hanebutt to approve the purchase of lumber and supplies to build an additional five boxes, NTE \$1,000. Carried

IV. BBQ Grills at Park Pavilions

Committee Chairman Donjon is still working on quotes. The utility department has work orders on removing the damaged BBQ grills.

V. Red Bud Athletic Association

This was addressed under the finance committee. The cost of the lift station for a new restroom needs to be addressed with the budget. Harbaugh asked if that would go

under the streets department or park department or where. Eckart said it would be included in the project if a grant was being applied for, but it is yet to be determined.
