I. Ratz Park Renovation Project Update

Jared Heller, Farnsworth Group, presented updates and site plans for the Ratz Park splashpad grant. The pad will be moved back due to the current utility access/lines. This will be closer to the pool. Fencing will be added. The recirculation water use is not feasible, (\$300,000 more expensive), so a flow through water system will be used. The daily operation of a recirculation system, vs. a flow through system, is more expensive. The city will be able to control when the water to the pad is usable. After discussion, the council members were in general agreement with the location change and the flow through water system.
