Old Business

**I. Swimming Pool**

A. Post Season Repairs Update

Chairman Donjon noted that the retaining wall looks great, but what is going on with the pool? Eckart said he is still getting people in to figure out the settlement in the filter problem. IDPH did their inspection and the few small issues have already been taken care of.

**II. Security Camera(s) – Lincoln Park, Ratz Park (Including Pool)**

Chief Brittingham said he and Susan Harbaugh had met with Secure One Self and did a walk-through at Lincoln and Ratz Parks, including the pool to determine what was needed.

***Recommendation made by Committee Chairman Donjon, seconded by Committee Member DeMond to authorize approval of the proposal from Secure One Self, NTE the amounts provided (Lincoln - \$4,630, Ratz - \$10,207, Pool - \$2,070.) Carried***

New Business

**I. Approval of Prior Month's Meeting Minutes – June 21, 2021**

***Recommendation made by Committee Chairman Donjon, seconded by Committee Member Hanebutt to approve the minutes from the June 21, 2021, meeting. Carried***

**III. OSLAD Grant Program**

Chairman Donjon said the OSLAD grants are open until September 1, 2021, and he would like to see the city apply for a splash pad \$400,000 grant. Attorney Ray noted that if an engineer is needed, approval to hire one must be made by the August meeting to meet the grant deadline.

***Recommendation made by Committee Chairman Donjon, seconded by Committee Member Harbaugh to authorize approval to apply for an OSLAD grant, NTE \$400,000. Carried***

**IV. Lion's Club/Golf Course Lake Treatment Information**

Superintendent Eckart mentioned that the golf course/Lion's Lake has a bad odor in the summer months. Chemco advised the use of oxidizer at a cost of approximately \$3,800 for chemicals between April and September. The NCCC may be interested in cost sharing with the city, if it is something the city wants to budget for next fiscal year.

**V. YMCA Financial Report for Pool**

The pool Statement of Operations report was included in the packet for May-June.

**VI. Playground Mulch**

***Recommendation made by Committee Chairman Donjon, seconded by Committee Member Nevois to authorize approval of the purchase of playground mulch from Davey, NTE \$1,500. Carried***

**VII. Pickle Ball – Court Paint**

The pickle ball courts have been used a lot and it is recommended that they be painted in a specific way. Donjon will get more information.

**VIII. Pickle Ball – Clinics**

Committee Member Harbaugh said that Dian Kiel had asked if the pickle ball courts can be reserved for clinics. Since this needs to be council approved, an email should be sent to city hall with the request, date, etc.

**IX. Pickle Ball – Places2Play**

Committee Member Harbaugh said that Places2Play is a national site listing pickle ball courts and she would like to get Red Bud listed. It is free and it will promote tourism. There were no objections.

**X. Lincoln Park Replacement Sign(s)**

***Recommendation made by Committee Chairman Donjon, seconded by Committee Member Hanebutt to authorize approval to order the signs as presented, except replace "beverages", with "glass", from Total Eclipse, Inc. (\$245). Carried***
