A. Special Request

Motion made by Council Member Esker, seconded by Council Member Linnertz to approve the request from Red Bud Chamber of Commerce to have the city provide sand for the volleyball court (split costs), electric access on the city parking lot (@Sporto's), closing parking lot on Friday for delivery of sand, barricades and detour signs, borrow picnic tables from Ratz Park Pavilion #4, with no fee, street closure from the square to WS Second Street for the Moonlight Madness Event on Saturday, July 30, 2016.
