

SCHEDULE “F”

PARKING ZONES

I. 30 MINUTES.

In accordance with Sections 153-1 and 153-3, it shall be unlawful for any person to park any vehicle for a period of more than one-half (1/2) hour between the hours of eight o’clock (8:00) a.m. and five o’clock (5:00) p.m. excepting Sundays and legal holidays in any of the areas designated. On Fridays the designated hours shall be extended to eight o’clock (8:00) p.m.

<u>STREET (SIDE)</u>		<u>LOCATION</u>
Bloom St. (East)	From	E. Market St. south to a distance of 100 feet.

II. RESERVED.

III. TWO HOURS.

In accordance with Sections 153-1 and 153-3, it shall be unlawful for any person to park any vehicle for a period of more than two (2) hours in any four (4) hour period between the hours of eight o’clock (8:00) a.m. and five o’clock (5:00) p.m. excepting Sundays and legal holidays in any of the areas designated. On Fridays the designated hours shall be extended to eight o’clock (8:00) p.m.

The removal of any motor vehicle from place to place within the following parking areas for the purpose of evading the provisions of Section 153 and this Schedule "F" regulating parking shall be deemed a subterfuge and a violation of said provisions.

W. S. 1 st St. (North)	From	S. Main St. to Oak St.
W. S. 2 nd St. (North)	From	S. Main St. to Oak St.
Lincoln St. (East)	From	W. Market St. to E. Red Bud St.
Main St. (West)	From	Olive St. to W. S. 1 st St.
Main St. (East)	From	Olive St. to E. S. 1 st St. except that parking on the east side of S. Main St. from E. S. 1 st St. and the driveway entrance to the Post Office is limited to five (5) minutes.
Market St. (North)	From	Locust St. to 115 feet east of Lincoln St.
Market St. (South)	From	Vine St. to Locust St.
Oak St. (Both)	From	W. Red Bud St. to W. S. 1 st St.

PARKING ZONES

IV. RESTRICTED PARKING.

In accordance with the provisions of Section 153-3, the following streets are hereby designated as “Restricted Parking Zones”, and it shall be unlawful to park a vehicle according to the following restrictions:

East S. 6th St. (south side) from S. Main St. to Bloom St. as extended easterly, during school hours except for loading and unloading passengers.

Hazel St. (west side) from the south line of West S. 5th St., north ninety-five (95) feet during school hours except for loading and unloading passengers.

W. Field St. (north side) from Locust St. to Janice St. from seven-thirty o’clock (7:30) a.m. to three-thirty o’clock (3:30) p.m. on school days.

On the parking lot on the north side and adjacent to the Post Office for any period longer than fifteen (15) minutes in any consecutive two (2) hour period.

On the east side of Bloom St. in the first 100 feet south of E. Market St., for any period longer than thirty (30) minutes in any consecutive two (2) hour period.

On the east side of Bloom St. starting one hundred (100) feet south of East Market St. and continuing for twenty-five (25) feet, only for police vehicles at all times.

The following streets shall be restricted to parking for the users of St. Peter’s United Church of Christ and the residents who live along said streets described below, to-wit:

W. Field St. (South)	From	Locust St. to Janice St. (for any period longer than 30 minutes during school hours)
Madison St. (Both)	From	Pine St. to Olive St.
Pine St. (Both)	From	Madison St. to Phillips St.
Randolph St. (Both)	From	Madison St. to Phillips St.
Randolph St. (Both)	From	Madison St. to end of Randolph St.

PARKING ZONES

V. RESIDENTIAL PARKING.

In accordance with the provisions of Section 153-3, the following streets are restricted to “Residential Parking Only”, and it shall be unlawful to park a vehicle unless you are a resident on the following street:

<u>STREET (SIDE)</u>		<u>LOCATION</u>
Campus Dr. (Both)	From	Meadow Dr. east to end of street
Charles St. (South)	From	Locust St. to Hilltop Dr.
Meadow Dr. (Both)	From	6 th St. south to end of street
Westfield Dr. (Both)	From	6 th St. south to end of street

VI. HANDICAPPED PARKING.

In accordance with the provisions of Section 153-3, it shall be unlawful to park any motor vehicle which is not bearing registration plates or decals issued to a handicapped person, as defined by 625 ILCS 5/1-159.1, pursuant to 625 ILCS 5/3-616 or 625 ILCS 5/11-1301.2 or to a disabled veteran pursuant to 625 ILCS 5/3-609, in the following street areas:

<u>STREET (SIDE)</u>		<u>LOCATION</u>
Bloom St. (East)	From	A point fifty (50) feet South of E. S. 4 th St. to a point one hundred twenty-five (125) feet South of E. S. 4 th St.
E. S. 1 st St. (South)	From	A point one hundred (100) feet East of S. Main St. to a point one hundred thirty-five (135) feet East of S. Main St.
E. S. 6 th St. (South)	From	A point one hundred eighty-five (185) feet East of S. Main St. to a point two hundred twenty-five (225) feet East of S. Main St.
Locust St. (East)	From	A point thirty-five (35) feet North of Brand Ave. to a point sixty-five (65) feet North of Brand Ave.
Locust St. (East)	From	A point forty (40) feet South of Brand Ave. to a point sixty (60) feet South of Brand Ave.

Madison St. (West)	From	A point eighty-five (85) feet North of Randolph St. to a point one hundred fifteen (115) North of Randolph St.
Randolph St. (North)	From	A point thirty (30) feet West of Madison St. to a point eighty (80) feet West of Madison St.
